### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants must be a current student or recent graduate of an Arkansas 4-year college or university, interested in the legal profession, and have an intent to take the LSAT upcoming summer or fall semester.

#### **Items Required for Application Consideration**

- 1. Completed application.
- 2. Write a letter to the selection committee, maximum 500 words, detailing the applicant's motivation for pursuing a career in the legal field. <u>Additionally</u>, choose one of the following essay questions to address:
  - a. What challenges or obstacles have you overcome and what have you learned from those experiences.
  - b. Share the challenges you've encountered as a member of an underrepresented group and how you've navigated through them.
  - c. Tell us about a time you successfully achieved a goal, outline the specific steps you took to reach it.
  - d. Describe a facet of your identity, background or personal story that shapes who you are.
- 3. Transcript (formal or informal transcripts accepted)
- 4. One letter of recommendation (from an undergraduate faculty member or advisor)

All required components of this application must be completed and sent in one email electronically or mailed as one packet and <u>received no later than Monday, April 15, 2024, at 5:00 PM.</u> Letter of recommendations may be included with the applicant's submission or provided separately by the recommender but must also be received to the address by due date.
