

Friday Forward Fellowship - Information and Application Requirements

The Friday Forward Fellowship was established by the attorneys at Friday, Eldredge & Clark, LLP to increase the number of law school candidates and law clerks from diverse backgrounds. Recognizing that diversity includes many human differences such as race, ethnicity, sexual and gender identity, military service, socioeconomic status, faith and beliefs, disability status, immigrant upbringing, and other conditions, we are committed to seeking out these populations in Arkansas colleges and universities to provide financial support and mentorship with the goal of inspiring a more diverse representation in the Arkansas legal profession.

The Friday Forward Fellowship will accept up to 10 students into the program each school year. These "Friday Fellows" will be provided financial aid to attend an LSAT prep course, personal mentorship with a firm attorney, and the opportunity to interview for a clerkship at the firm during law school. Mentor attorneys will work with each Friday Fellow throughout their law school experience by providing advice and guidance to help fellows succeed in school and in their legal career.

Friday Fellows will be selected by a committee comprised of attorneys and Arkansas law school administrators and/or faculty members. Applicants must be a current student or recent graduate of an Arkansas 4-year college or university, interested in the legal profession, and have an intent to take the LSAT upcoming summer or fall semester.

- Completed application
- Letter to committee (maximum 500 words) addressing why applicant wants to pursue a career in the legal field PLUS answer one of the essay questions below:
 - 1) What struggles have you faced being a part of an underrepresented group?
 - 2) Tell us about a time you reached a goal and what steps you took to achieve it.
 - 3) Describe a facet of your identity, background or story that is essential to who you are.
- Transcript (formal or informal transcripts accepted)
- One letter of recommendation (from an undergraduate faculty member or advisor)

The application, letter, and transcript should be <u>sent together</u> via email or standard mail and must be **received no later than Monday April 3rd, 2023 at 5pm.** All completed submissions will be collected and forwarded directly to the selection committee. The letter of recommendation may be included with the applicant's submission or provided separately but must also be received by due date. Submissions should be addressed to:
