She has argued before the Arkansas Supreme Court on issues such as the constitutionality of the Arkansas Civil Justice Reform Act.

Jamie has lectured extensively on issues surrounding electronic discovery and on online research at the Arkansas Bar Association's Annual Meeting and Mid-Year Meeting, Eighth Circuit Practicum and Best of CLE.
